I am always amused by the people who try to cling to a heritage that they are so removed from. Take for instance the blacks who wear the traditional African

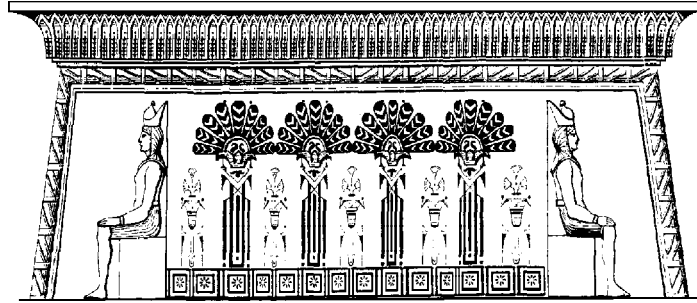

# Bumper Stickers



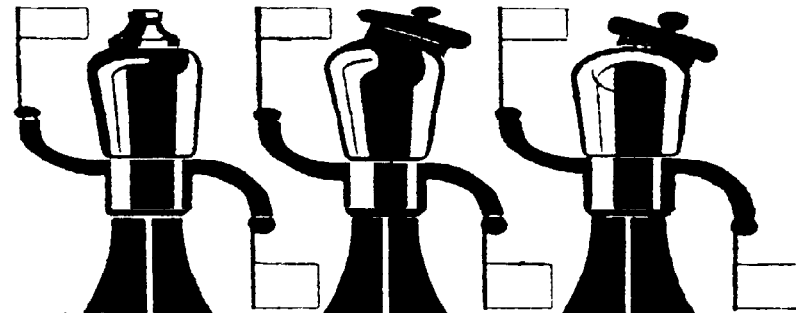
## The hieroglyphics of our civilization

# Demonic Possession is 9/10ths of Politics

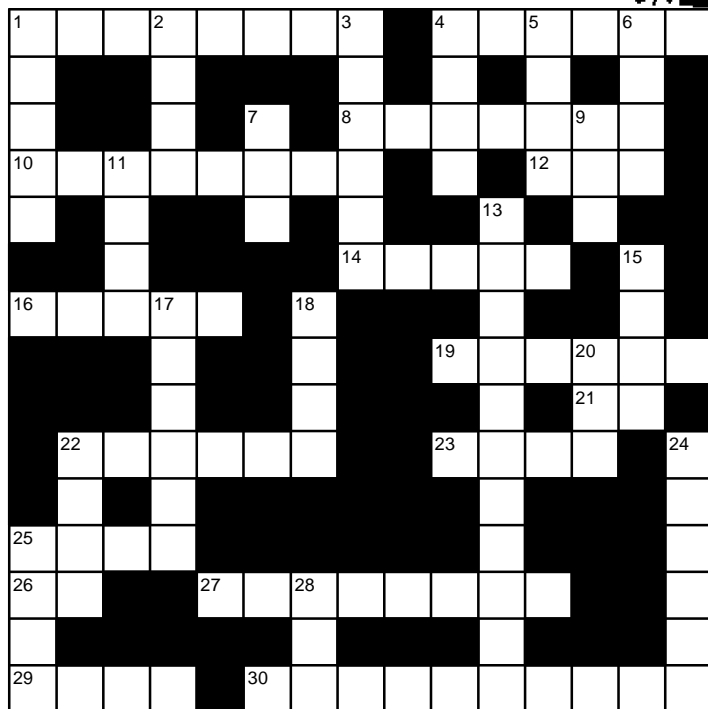
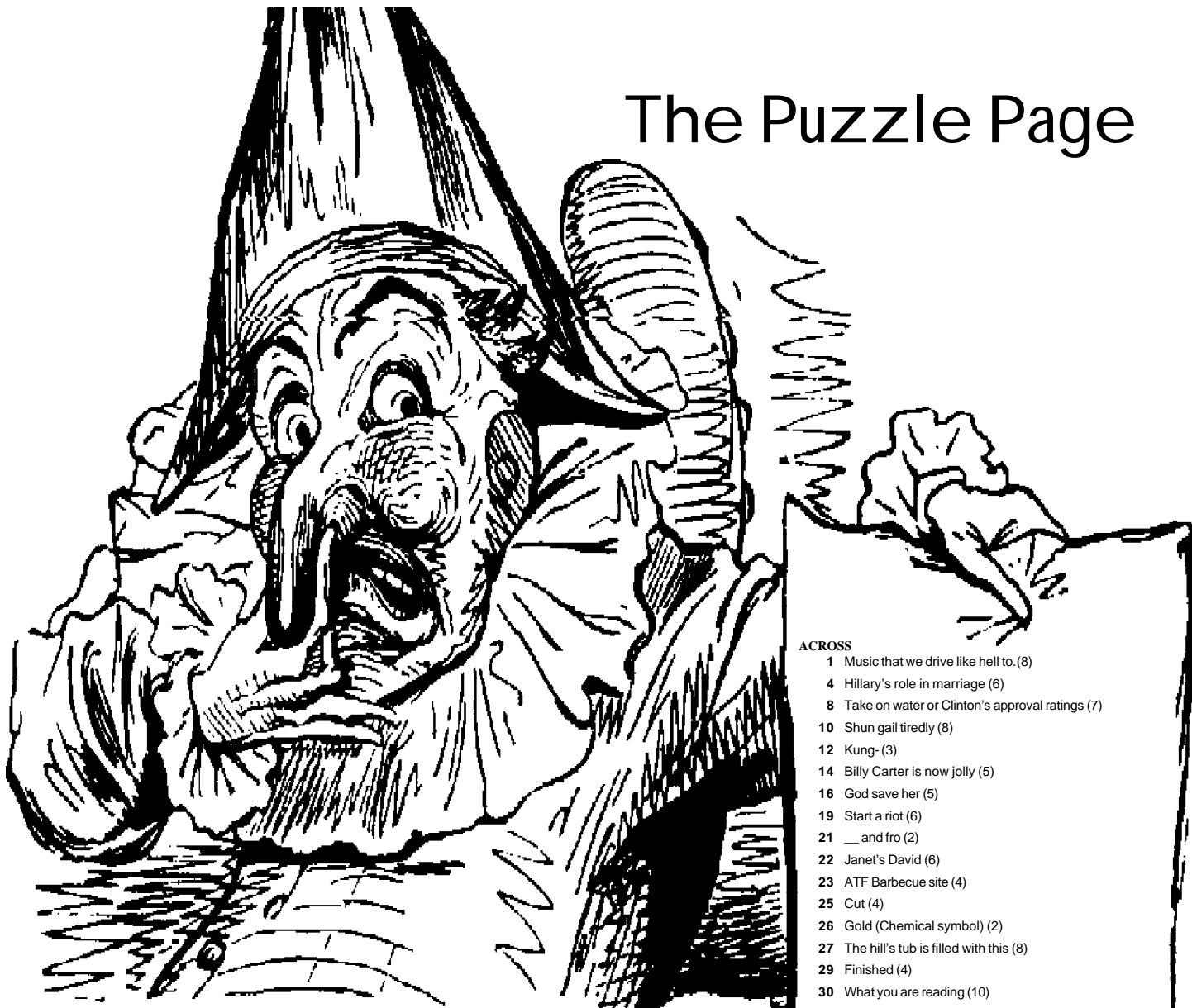

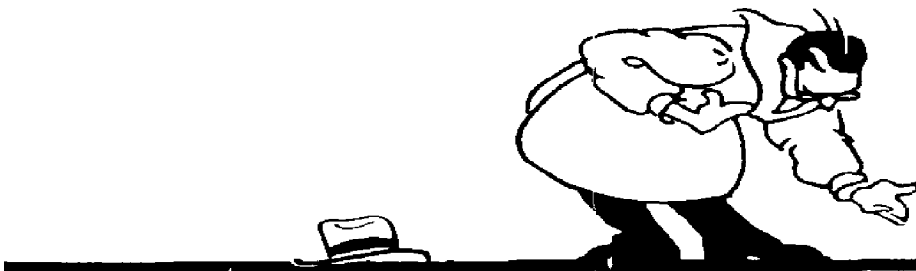
