



Video Screening: "Sin City Diaries" Friday, 12 May 2000, 3:00 p.m. UCSB Multicultural Center Theater

A 40 minute collection of interviews with Filipina prostitutes, "Sin City Diaries" links prostitution in the Philippines to the presence of the u.s. military and widespread, terrible poverty. Because of the bourgeois Manila government's subserviance to the united States and widespread corruption, the bourgeois government has not been able to solve the problems facing Filipinas and Filipinos, such as prostitution.

Activists from GABRIELA-LA (a national-democratic wimmin's organization) and BAYAN-USA will facilitate the screening and discuss the present situation in the Philippines, touching on subjects like the Visiting Forces Agreement, which again gives the u.s. military wide access to the Philippines.
