
## The Free Books for Prisoners Program

is a radical program organizing for revolutionary change. MIM and RAIL send books on US history, Black, Latino and First Nation history and nationalism, global independence movements and revolutionary organizing free to prisoners. The goal is to provide the educational materials necessary for prisoners to build revolutionary organizations, and through national self-determination, liberate their brothers and sisters from the oppressive yoke of imperialism.



MIM and RAIL constantly receiv — e requests from prisoners for material that the imperialist injustice system will not allow them to have. These materials focus primarily on how to change the reality of poverty, racism, militarism and overall national oppression that many prisoners face in their daily lives, behind and outside the prison walls. Prisoners are asking why most people in prison are poor, why it is that Amerikkka answers to social inequality by locking up the have nots, why oppressed nationals are disproportionately incarcerated and why the prison budget is growing at exponential rates while education, housing, and job availability for Blacks, Latinos and First Nations is inadequate.

The US imper ialist government is only answering these questions with further repression. Prison libraries are being closed, personal items are being thrown away, mail is being censored and communication costs are rising. MIM and RAIL work to end these injustices while putting the power in the hands of the oppressed. Concretely, we are fighting winnable legal battles to stop censorship in prisons, and continuing the struggle to get needed revolutionary educational material to prisoners.

The imper ialists are well organized, having a full gang of their own in blue on the streets and in suits behind administrative desks. The revolutionary movement needs an army too. Right now we need help fund-raising, mailing and responding to letters, and raising public awareness about prison injustice.
