NAME

akfquery - use form data via CGI in shell scripts

SYNOPSIS

```
akfquery field_name [alternative]
```

DESCRIPTION

With the program **akfquery** you can use forms with the **GET**-method in shell scripts.

A *field_name* must be provided. The program outputs the decoded field value to the standard output. If the field doesn't exist or if it is empty, then it outputs the *alternative*, if given. Otherwise the output is empty.

If the field has multiple values, the program outputs multiple lines. This can happen for example with checkboxes.

Special HTML-characters (<>&"') are converted to HTML-enities.

Warning

Shell scripts are suitable for quick temporary solutions or drafts in local, private networks. But they shouldn't be used for productive work on the open Internet.

ENVIRONMENT

QUERY STRING

contains the form data with the method GET

EXAMPLES

```
# save in variable for reuse
name=$(akfquery name "unknown")

echo "Hello $name."

# for single use output you can directly include it
# the line breaks don't really matter for HTML
echo "age:"
akfquery age
echo ""

# hobby is done with checkboxes
echo ""
for i in $(akfquery hobby "no hobbys")
do
        echo "$i
" done
echo ""
```
